

TTD assets case adjourned to Sept 14

Hyderabad, Aug 27 (TNN): In the sensational assets case of Lord Venkateswara, the Andhra Pradesh High Court on Thursday directed the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) administration to submit to the court all the details pertaining to the temple assets before October 31.

Adjourning the case for further hearing to September 14, the High Court told the TTD administration to submit to the court before October 31 all the details of the whole assets of various temples managed by the TTD in the State. However, the court has given time

till November 30 for submitting the details of the assets owned by the temple outside Andhra Pradesh.

An advocate from Nellore has filed the case before the High Court seeking details of the whole assets, including the invaluable jewelry of Lord Venkateswara. The petitioner suspected that many valuables of the Lord, presented by several pilgrims for the past many years, are missing. Meanwhile, the priest at the Lord Kodandarama Swamy temple in Tirupati, Ramana Deekshitulu, and the two pawn brokers are sent for three days police custody on Thursday.

TNN reports from Tirupati that the priest along with the two pawn brokers were taken into custody for pledging the jewelry of the Lord. The priest and the pawn brokers were sent for three days in police custody on Thursday.

In another development, Rs 20 crore worth of jewelry is suspected to be missing from the Hathiramji Mutt in Tirupati. While the mutt administration says that the jewelry is stored in a locker with a bank at Chandragiri town, near Tirupati, the bank management, however, says that there is no such locker owned by the mutt. Hence, suspense continues over the security of the jewelry.

Two women die of swine flu in Nashik; toll rises to six in city

Nasik, August 27 : The death toll due to swine flu has risen to six in the city with two more women, one of them pregnant, succumbing to the viral infection. Purva Amol Joshi (23), who was pregnant, and Deepali Shinde (20) died on Wednesday at the Nashik Civil Hospital and Municipal Corporation's Dr Zakir Hussain Hospital respectively, A D Bhalsingh, surgeon at Nashik Civil Hospital, said on Thursday. Both the victims were local residents. Reports from Pune's National Institute of Virology confirmed that they were positive for H1N1 virus, he said. Earlier, four persons, including a doctor, had died in the civil hospital due to the viral disease, Dr. Bhalsingh said. Three patients, who tested negative for H1N1, are being treated in the Civil Hospital and they are likely to be discharged soon as their condition has improved, he said.

India eyes \$200 billion export; doles out sops

New Delhi, August 27 : India today extended tax holiday and duty refund for exporters, while allowing duty free capital goods import under its Foreign Trade Policy to insulate them from protectionism induced by recession abroad. Unveiling the five-year policy, the Commerce Minister,

Anand Sharma, set a target of \$200 billion worth exports for next fiscal, a feat that India failed to achieve in 2008-09 due to a slump in global demand in the face of financial crisis. "India has not been affected to the same extent as other economies of the world, yet our exports have suffered

a decline in the last 10 months due to a contraction in demand in the traditional markets. The protectionist measures being adopted by some of these countries have aggravated the problem," Mr. Sharma said, presenting his first trade policy. While exports for the April-June quar-

ter contracted by 31 per cent, Mr. Sharma set a growth target of 15 per cent for financial year 2010. "I would be hesitant to hazard a guess on the nature and extent of this recovery and the time the major economies will take to return to there pre-recession growth levels," he said.
